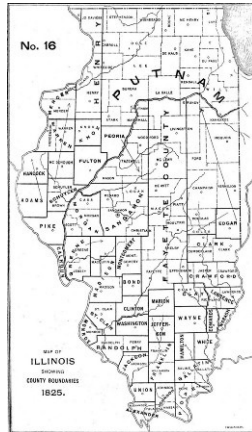


Getting Started: Researching in a New Geographic Area
