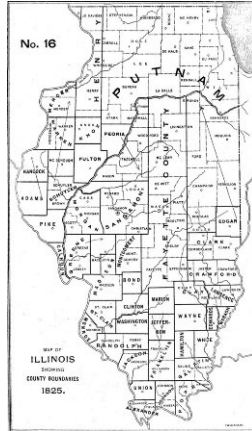


# Researching in a New Geographic Area
